- A) Were you removed to **Mexico** from **Southern California** anytime from **June 1, 2009 to August 28, 2014**?
- B) Did you accept a **voluntary return**? Did you waive your right to see an immigration judge?
- C) Did you **have a reasonable claim to remain in the U.S.** at the time you accepted the voluntary return?
- D) Are you in Mexico?

If you can answer "YES" to all of these questions, you may be able to apply to return to the U.S. to fight your case in front of an immigration judge.
