

LET ME VOTE

Primary Election Day is Tuesday, June 7, 2016

- ✓ **You need to be registered to vote.** You can check your registration status on the county elections office's website before Election Day. The last day to register for the June election is May 23, 2016.
- ✓ **If you vote at the polls:** Vote at your assigned polling place between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. on June 7th. Your polling place is listed on the back of the sample ballot you received in the mail a few weeks before Election Day.
- ✓ **If you vote by mail, SIGN and MAIL your ballot** so the elections office receives it before June 7th. If you're not sure the ballot will be received in time, you can drop your ballot at any polling site in your county on Election Day between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m.

Do I need an ID to vote? You do NOT need photo identification to vote in California.

Do I need to vote on everything on the ballot? No. You don't need to vote on every race or issue. You can choose the things that are most important to you.

If I vote by mail, what if I haven't sent it in time to be received by Election Day? All mail-in ballots must be received by your county elections office by 8 pm on Election Day. If you're not sure your ballot will be received in time, you can drop it off at any polling site on Election Day.

What if someone tells me I cannot vote? Do not leave the polling place without voting! Just say: "I believe I am registered to vote in this county. I would like to vote using a provisional ballot." A provisional ballot is used when there are questions about a voter's eligibility that need to be cleared up. Submit your provisional ballot, and then contact us.
