Race, Sex and Revenge in a Boston Courtroom*

Broken Justice tells the true story of a young, black doctor who arrived in Boston in 1971 to complete his residency in obstetrics and gynecology. In 1974, he was indicted for manslaughter in the death of a fetus during a legal abortion, charged by an zealous anti-abortion prosecutor seeking to challenge the legal underpinnings of *Roe v. Wade*.

Dr. Edelin is currently touring the country, speaking to gatherings large and small to **emphasize the importance of protecting a woman's right to choose, which is being threatened in virtually every state of the union.**

By January 22nd, a new president will have been sworn in. Dr. Edelin will speak to the new realities the country and women are likely to face with a new administration and the likelihood of changes in the federal judiciary and on the U.S. Supreme Court.
